What's Happening at Linwood

The Fall Ramble is set for Thursday, October 23rd. This year's theme features photography in two ways. First, on our tours we'll be telling you about some interesting Columbus photographers, including Louis Pacetty, Constantine De George, Clarence Gray, Ernst Jungermann, J.J. Fogle and Tiff Moore. Second, we'll be stopping at some gravesites that are featured in our new book *Linwood Through the Lens*, which will be for sale at the Ramble. The book is comprised of over 150 black and white artistic photos that were taken in the cemetery in 2013 by area photographers. As usual, following the tours we'll have a fabulous buffet (catered by Joni Ressmeyer), along with a well-stocked bar. Tickets are now on sale! Get yours today!

As you know, The Foundation has recently been awarded a \$300,000.00 grant from the Mildred Miller Fort Foundation that will allow us to proceed with the restoration of several critical areas of the cemetery. This is a matching grant, and the Fort Foundation has challenged us to raise \$140,000.00 to bring this project to its full cost of \$440,000.00.
